The City Cemeteries Advisory Committee (Lone Oak, Cook, Whorley) of the City of Lewisburg met Tuesday, April 27, 2021 at 4:00 PM at Lewisburg City Hall.

Member present: City Manager Buck Beard, Charlotte Foster, Councilman C.H. Harwell, Ken White and Tina Carter.

Members Absent: Sidney Mayberry, Angie Burditt and Betty Bigger.

Others present: William Langley and Harold Foster.

Motion was made by Ken White, seconded by Councilman Harwell to approve the minutes from the June 30, 2020 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business:

Report on 2020 donations received: Yr. 2020 - \$2,790.00 (down due to COVID Pandemic)
Yr. 2019 - \$5,060.00

New Business:

Discussed raising plot fees from \$200 per plot to \$400.00 per plot. Lueshell Taylor contacted surrounding cities to inquire of their plot fees which ranged from \$400.00 each to \$2,295.00. City Manager Beard suggested that the board make a recommendation to the Council to raise the plot fees to \$400.00 each. The board agreed. If approved by Council a public notice will be published of the increase sometime in July 2021 with an effective date of the increase to be January 1, 2022.

The Lewisburg Fire Department will be stationed at Lone Oak on Saturday, May 8th and Sunday, May 9th during decoration to take up donations. Signs will be placed a Cook Cemetery where to send donations too.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
