

ORDINANCE 22-27

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 10, CHAPTER 1, BY ADDING SUBSECTION 10-112, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO REMOVAL OF ANIMAL WASTE

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisburg is determined to keep city facilities including all parks and public property clean for general day to day and public events;

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisburg has recognized that the owners of dogs have not taken responsibility to remove waste deposited by his/her animal in city owned cemeteries, on public walks, recreation areas and public parks and private property not lawfully possessed by the dog owner.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LEWISBURG THAT:

- 1. Title 10, Chapter 1, of the Municipal Code be amended as follows by adding:

10-112 . **Excrement.** A dog owner or person in possession of the dog shall clean up and remove any excrement left by his or her dog(s) on any public property or private property not owned or lawfully possessed by the dog owner. Violations of this section shall be punishable by a fifty-dollar fine \$50.00.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect 15 days from and after its passage on Second and final reading, the municipal welfare requiring it.
