

ORDINANCE 22-17

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF LEWISBURG MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO FEE SCHEDULES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISBURG THAT THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS BE MADE TO THE RESPECTIVE SECTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE AND SHALL NOW READ AS FOLLOWS:

TITLE 14 – ZONING & LAND USE CONTROL

CHP. 5 SIGN CODE; Sect. 14-511. Permits and fees.

- (2) The sign permit fee shall be one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per sign.

TITLE 18 – WATER & SEWERS

CHP. 3 STORMWATER ORDINANCE; Sect. 18-313. Fee Schedule.

- (1) Permit review and inspection fees. A fee shall be assessed for each land disturbance permit as set forth in the following table:

| DISTURBED ACKERAGE | FROM | TO |
|--------------------|----------|----------|
| 0.01 -- 0.99 | \$50 | \$100 |
| 1.00 -- 5.00 | \$100 | \$500 |
| 5.00 -- 10.00 | \$500 | \$1,000 |
| 10.00 -- 20.00 | \$1,000 | \$2,000 |
| 20.00 -- 30.00 | \$2,000 | \$3,000 |
| 30.00 -- 100.00 | \$3,000 | \$10,000 |
| >100.00 | \$10,500 | |

TITLE 14 – ZONING & LAND USE CONTROL

CHP. 2 ZONING ORDINANCE

- 1) This ordinance and any amendments thereto, are published as separate documents and are of record in the office of the City Codes Officer.
2) For reference purposes only in this document the current amendments to the Zoning Ordinance are shown below in red.

7.080. Variances.

B. Fee: A fee of three hundred fifty (\$350) dollars payable to the City of Lewisburg shall be charged to cover partial review and processing of each application for a variance, except that the fee shall be waived for a governmental agency.

7.090. Zoning Text Amendments to the ordinance. A fee of five hundred (\$500) dollars payable to the City of Lewisburg shall be charged to cover partial review and processing of each application for an amendment, except that the fee shall be waived for a governmental agency.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance takes effect 15 days from and after its passage on second (2nd) and final reading, the municipal welfare requiring it.
