The City of Lewisburg Planning and Zoning Commission will hold a Public Hearing Tuesday, January 17, 2023, at 3:50 PM at Lewisburg Gas Department, 505 N Ellington Pkwy, followed by their regular meeting at 4:00 PM. The public hearing will be to hear comments or opinions concerning the following:

a. Article IV, Section 4-108.1 of the Subdivision Regulations shall be deleted in its entirety and be amended as follows:

4-108.1 Sidewalks

ADA compliant sidewalks of five-foot width shall be installed within all new subdivisions of property within the City of Lewisburg. If the subdivision requires sidewalks along a roadway identified as a Lewisburg Corridor then the additional requirements of the Lewisburg Corridor Special District shall apply. Sidewalks will be required for both minor and major subdivisions regardless of whether any roadway construction is required for the subdivision or not. If the subdivision is located in an area where no adjoining sidewalks exist, then the developer may choose to pay into a Sidewalk Construction Fund in lieu of constructing the sidewalk. For subdivisions that require new roadway construction the sidewalk will be expected to be constructed unless unique conditions warrant the Planning Commission approving otherwise. The amount to be paid into the Sidewalk Construction Fund will be \$12 per square foot of sidewalk that would be required to span the width of the lot frontage included within the subdivision. The City of Lewisburg will utilize the Sidewalk Construction Fund to construct sidewalks where and when the City of Lewisburg deems appropriate.

The motion passed 7 - 0.

Item 5. Board/Staff Comments:

Ms. Woods discussed the EnviroMedics business in the Historic District. She was concerned about future businesses and what can be done to prevent this from happening again. Mr. Patterson stated that something could be added to the Historic Zoning Guidelines requiring permitted uses.
