Consider approval of seconding reading of Ordinance 25-09, an ordinance by owner request to rezone property located at 650 Spring Place Road, (Map 071B, Grp C, Parcel 026.00 within the corporate limits of the City of Lewisburg, from I-1 (Light Industrial) to C-2 (Intermediate Business). Consider approval of first reading of Annexation Resolution 25-13, a resolution requested by the Marshall County Highway Department to annex approx. 1 mile of Finley Beech Road describes as: from the WEST starting point of CSM Allen B. Wortham Memorial Bridge going EAST 1 mile to the end of 1404 Robin Hood Road; (Map 072, Parcel 001.00) into the corporate limits of the City of Lewisburg. The Planning Commission gave an unfavorable recommendation by 5-0 votes.

Consider approval of first reading of Annexation Resolution 25-14, a resolution requested by the Marshall County Highway Department to annex approx. 1 mile of Robin Hood Road describes as: from the NORTH starting point of intersection of Finley Beech Road and Rogin Hood Road going South 1 mile to the end of 1480 Fayetteville Hwy; (Map 064, Parcel 038.00) into the corporate limits of the City of Lewisburg. The Planning Commission gave an unfavorable recommendation by 5-0
