New Business:

Public Comments/Citizens Input: Phillip Baxter 1301 Old Farmington Road is opposed to hiring any consulting firms.

**a. Interview candidates for City Manager position.**

**b. Possibly select a candidate for City Manager position.**

Discussion ensued about candidates.

Councilman Michael made motion to consider Scott Collins and to offer Mr. Collins the position once we determine the salary. Councilman Thomas seconded the motion.

Councilman Michael made motion to withdrawal motion on the table and seconded by Councilman Thomas.

Councilman Michael made a new motion to offer the position of City Manager to Scott Collins pending salary negotiation agreement. Councilman Thomas seconded the motion.

**c. Consider start date and salary for City Manager.**
